

### **Turn four of your lucky numbers** into cash!

### How it works

You win by matching your 4 numbers to the draw numbers. How you match and what you match determines your prize.

### How to play

Using a Pick 4 game slip, it's as easy as 1, 2, 3, 4.

- Choose your four numbers (0-9) or mark the Quick Pick (QP) box on the game slip.
- Choose your game options. Pick 4 offers seven ways to win.
- Choose your wager amount-\$.50 or \$1. The minimum you can play per game slip is \$1 per drawing.
- Choose the number of drawings in a row you want to play these numbers—up to 12 drawings.

Give your game slip to a clerk at any Oregon Lottery® retail

location or use the self-service terminal.



# Play The Easy Way

Just say "Give me a Pick 4 Quick Pick" and give the Lottery retailer \$1. Your number will be placed automatically. You'll get a ticket similar to the one below.

# Play For Advanced Players: Match in Exact Order

Pick 4<sup>st</sup> also offers players the chance to win by trying to match their numbers in the exact order that they are drawn.

- 1 Choose your four numbers (0–9) or mark the Quick Pick (QP) box on the game slip.
- 2 Choose your game options. Pick 4 offers seven ways to win.
- 3 Choose your wager amount— \$.50 or \$1. The minimum you can play per game slip is \$1 per drawing.
- 4 Choose the number of drawings in a row you want to play these numbers—up to 12 drawings.



# Exact Order 4 Example

Winning Numbers:

6892

You matched all 4 in exact order.

You win \$5,000

You matched first 3 in exact order.

You win \$300

You matched last 3

in exact order.

You win \$300

# Play For Advanced Players: Match in Any Order

If you choose to match your numbers in any order, a new element is added to the game. The prize and odds vary depending on which numbers you pick: identical or different from each other. See examples in prize charts.



Winning Numbers: 1234

You matched all 4 in any order.

You win \$250

You matched first 3 in

any order.

You win \$50

You matched last 3 in any order.

You win \$50
